International Adoptions from China, Thailand and Korea

Our international adoption programs are long established and reliable. New Beginnings' mission is to find orphaned and displaced children permanent loving homes by providing quality and compassionate social services through the adoption process and after the child is placed.

Korean Children Need Families

We need families for healthy Korean children for the coming year. The Korean program is still one of the best international adoption programs available. Families were often able to bring their child home in less than 14 months.

Post Adoption Services

In 2018 New Beginnings' Beyond the Placement Program received 92 requests for post adoption services and 32 request for birth parent searches. We currently have 13 adoptees having ongoing contact with birth family members.

Exceptional Adoptions

The average age of the children place this year has gone up. We place four teenagers from Sierra Leone with their aunt and uncle; Five siblings from South Sudan with their aunt and uncle. We placed twins from Togo with their aunt and uncle; a teenage from Togo with has aunt. Teenagers from Jamaica and Nigeria.

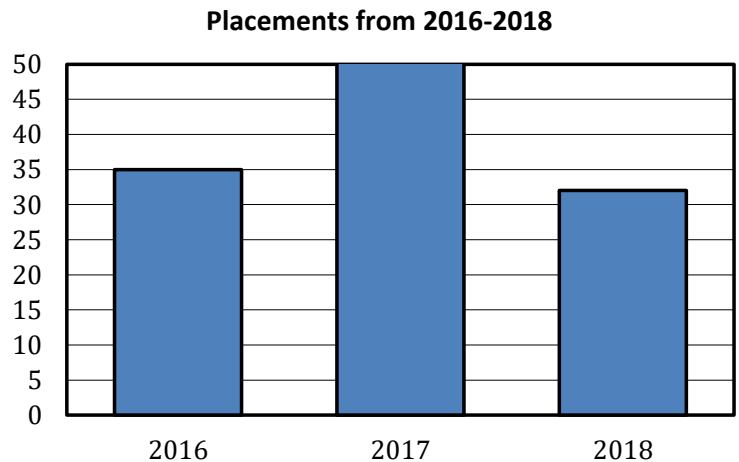

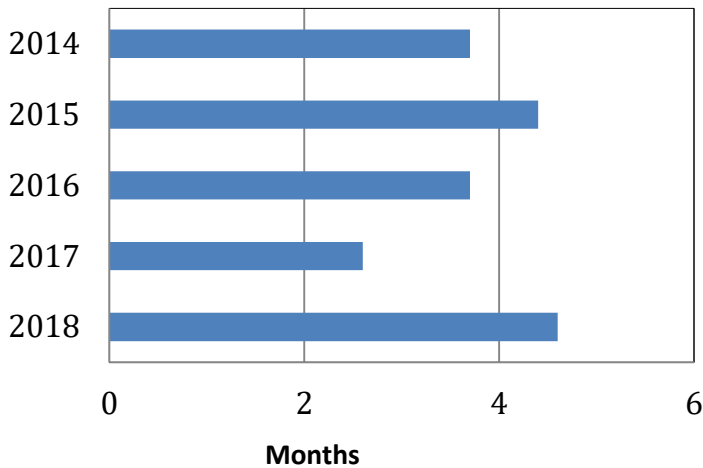

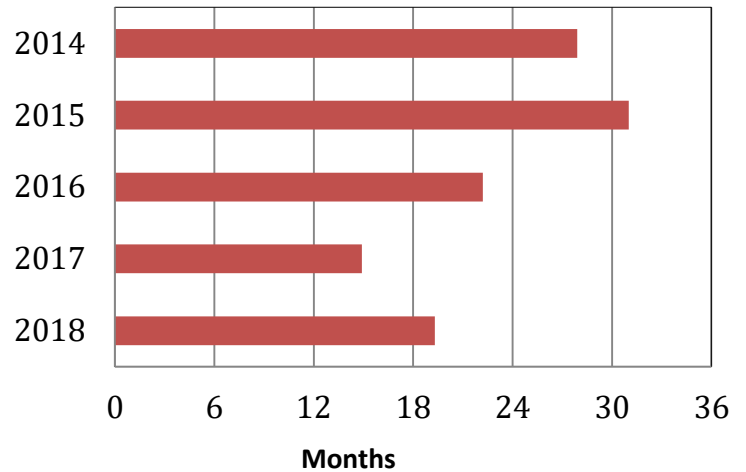

Contract to Home Study

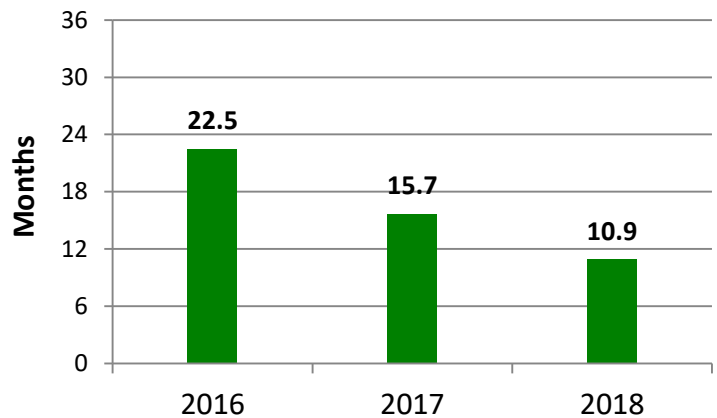


Home Study to Placement



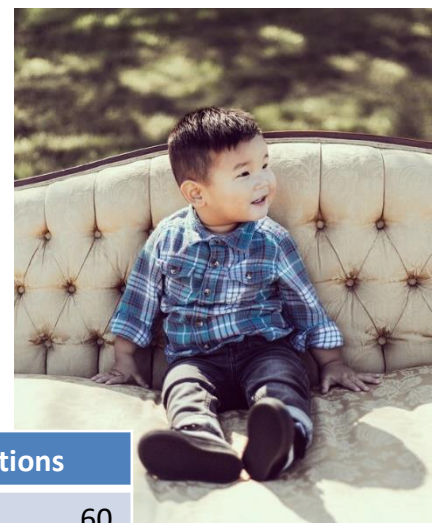
