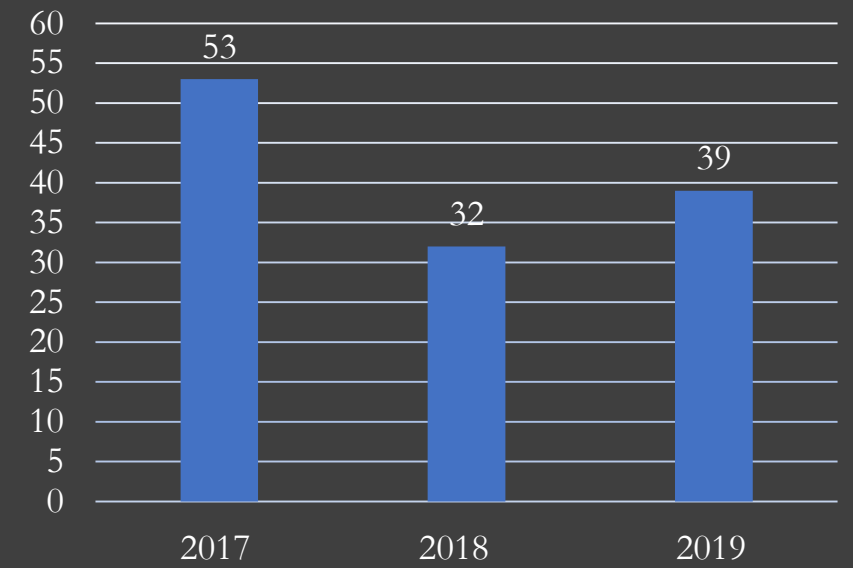

Placements from 2017-2019

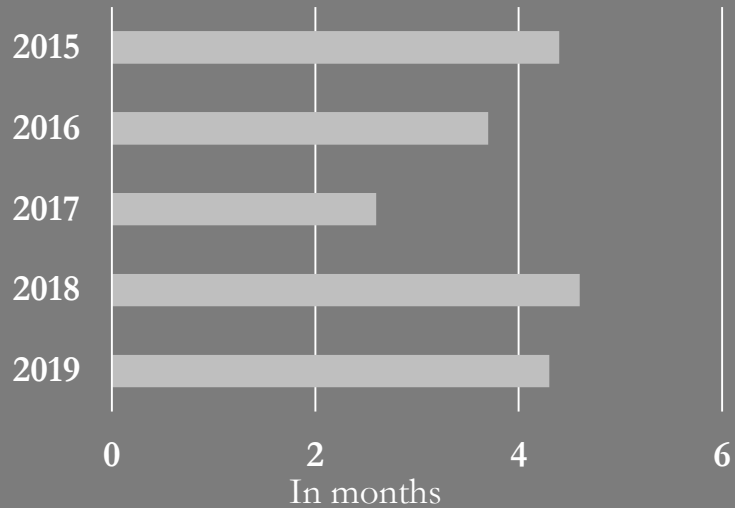

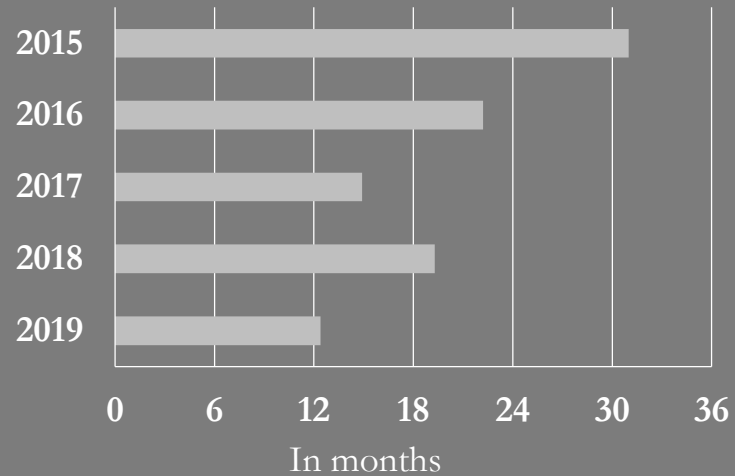

How long does it take?

In 2019, it took NB an average of 4.3 months to complete the Home Study and another 12.4 months from the Home Study to the placement of the child.

The total average time to complete the adoption process was 16.7 months
